Replacement of article (5) of Resolution (29) 2020 Regarding the regulation of the health professions licensure examination system At the National Health Regulatory Authority

Chairman of the Supreme Council of Health:

After review of Resolution No. (29) of 2020 regarding the regulation of the health professions licensure examination system at the National Health Regulatory Authority,

And based on the proposal of the CEO of the National Health Regulatory Authority, and after the approval of the Supreme Council of Health in its session held on December 24, 2020,

The following has been decided:

Article one

Replace the text of Article (5) of Resolution No. (29) of 2020 regarding the regulation of the health professions licensure examination system of the National Health Regulatory Authority, with the following text:

In addition to the conditions and standards necessary for licensing, the requirement to pass the examination required by the authority as a condition for obtaining this license is added for the following health professions:
